





Assessment quality





Quality outcomes from VET are fundamental to ensuring a skilled workforce and supporting a productive economy.

In a competency-based system, assessment is the gatekeeper for quality.

An incompetent graduate that is deemed competent could have a negative impact on employers and the workplace or seriously affect safety.

Such flawed qualifications may also have a broader impact on public confidence in nationally recognised training and the reputation of Australia's VET sector.

Terminology






- What is a system?
