



- Born 1913, died 1997
- Famous for applying the theory of andragogy (adult learning)

Assumptions about adult learners work Skills



- 1. Adults need to know why they need to learn something
- 2. Adults like self-direction
- 3. Adults come to training with experience
- 4. Adults want training to be relevant to them
- 5. Adults learn best when they can immediately apply what they are learning to real-life situations
- 6. Adults learn best when motivated

 - Evaluation


